

## Plus and Minus

Development is mechanical and being mechanical the best results are obtained by a strict use by rule of the three factors—strength of developer, temperature of developer and length of development.





THE tank development of film does away with the dark room. By simple methods it gives a quality that was unobtainable by the old methods.

To develop in the tank the film is simply wound on the transferring reel in a light tight box, a process as simple as loading the Kodak; transferred in daylight to the cup containing the developing solution; left for ten or twenty minutes, according to the strength of developer, rinsed and removed in daylight to the tray of fixing solution.

## Brownie Developing Box

THE Brownie Developing Box is a simplification of the Kodak Tank, such simplification being made possible by the short length of the No. 1 and No. 2 Brownie film.

The No. 2 Brownie Developing Box is a metal box fifteen inches in length, just long enough to accommodate a roll of No. 1 or No. 2 Brownie film in one loop. To develop, the roll of film is inserted in the spool carrier and by means of a cord and winding shaft, the film is unrolled and carried around a roller bearing, thus exposing the entire surface to the action of the developer.

When the film is developed the developer is poured off and the box filled with water to thoroughly wash out the developer. The film may then be removed in daylight to the fixing bath.
