Vest Pocket Kodak

SO flat and smooth and small as to easily go into a Vest Pocket, this excellent little camera can accompany you everywhere unobtrusively, and it is always ready for action. Just pull out the front to its full extent and the Kodak is in focus for objects at any distance.


It makes $1\frac{5}{8} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ pictures, and has a lens of such superior definition that excellent enlargements can be made from its negatives. With a Vest Pocket Kodak Enlarging Camera (see page 28) any amateur can easily make $3\frac{1}{4} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$ enlargements, or he can have them made for him for fifteen cents each. And, of course, much larger enlargements may be had if desired.

The shutter is the Kodak Ball Bearing, fitted with iris diaphragm and Kodak Autotime Scale, and working for time, bulb, 1-25 and 1-50 second exposures.

While it is remarkably compact, it is carefully made in every detail, nothing in the way of simplicity or efficiency having been sacrificed in order to reduce the size.

The lens is a meniscus achromatic of exceptional quality and each one is given a rigid test.




Nos. 3 and 3^A Special Kodaks

THE advantages of the Special type of Kodak have already been referred to in our description of the No. 1A Special. And all that was said of that instrument applies also to the Nos. 3 and 3A Specials.

They have the same type of lens and shutter—the Zeiss-Kodak Anastigmat, f-6.3 lens and Compound shutter, and their equipments include the rising and sliding front, rack and pinion for focusing, spirit level, nickeled fittings and morocco covering.


A LTHOUGH this camera will easily make pictures of the fastest moving objects, such as automobiles, express trains, athletes and race horses, it can be just as easily used for home portraiture, and all other ordinary amateur work.

Its high speed is attained by the incorporation of a Graflex focal plane shutter in its construction, which permits a latitude of exposures varying from $\frac{1}{1000}$ of a second to very slow, instantaneous, bulb, or time exposures. The shutter can be instantly wound by the half turn of a key, and released by merely touching a lever.

Rack and pinion is furnished for easy focusing, metal parts have gun-metal finish, and covering is a very fine grain leather.
